

GLOBAL ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING ORGANIZATION RALLIES TENS OF THOUSANDS WORLDWIDE TO COMBAT MODERN-DAY SLAVERY

This Saturday, October 20, 2018, tens of thousands of people all over the world will gather and participate in the annual Walk For Freedom, a fundraising and awareness event calling for an end to modern-day slavery.

In one of the largest global activations of its kind, people are set to walk in over 450 cities across more than 50 nations.



Operated by a global anti-human trafficking organization, A21, the annual Walk For Freedom aims to engage people in raising awareness of the millions of men, women, and children who are trapped in slavery today. By fundraising and rallying thousands around the cause, the Walk For Freedom acts as the catalyst for the identification and restoration of exploited persons through A21's global work in the United States, United Kingdom, Thailand, Greece, Ukraine, Bulgaria, Norway, Netherlands, Denmark, Spain, South Africa, and Australia.

Every year the Walk For Freedom is distinctly visible, with participants wearing black shirts and walking in single-file through the centers of cities, towns and villages all over the world. Hundreds of local walks will be seen marching for a global end to modern-day slavery.

“We are convinced that if we do this together, if we keep showing up, if we continue to be tenacious, if we continue to turn up with strength, numbers, and courage, then we can see slavery eradicated in our lifetime,” says A21’s founder Christine Caine.
